If you are proposing a field tour, please describe the proposed itinerary, what types of restoration techniques will be showcased, and potential collaborators. Please include a few high-resolution photos.

Sessions are approximately 3.5 hours and are limited to six presenters. Workshops are 9am to 5pm and should have an interactive component with key objectives rather than be a series of case studies. SRF utilizes a Public Call for Abstracts and encourages including a diverse range of presenters from various affiliations. Even if you invite potential presenters, SRF respectfully requests that you review all abstracts and ask invited presenters to submit an abstract according to the Call for Abstracts' timeline.
