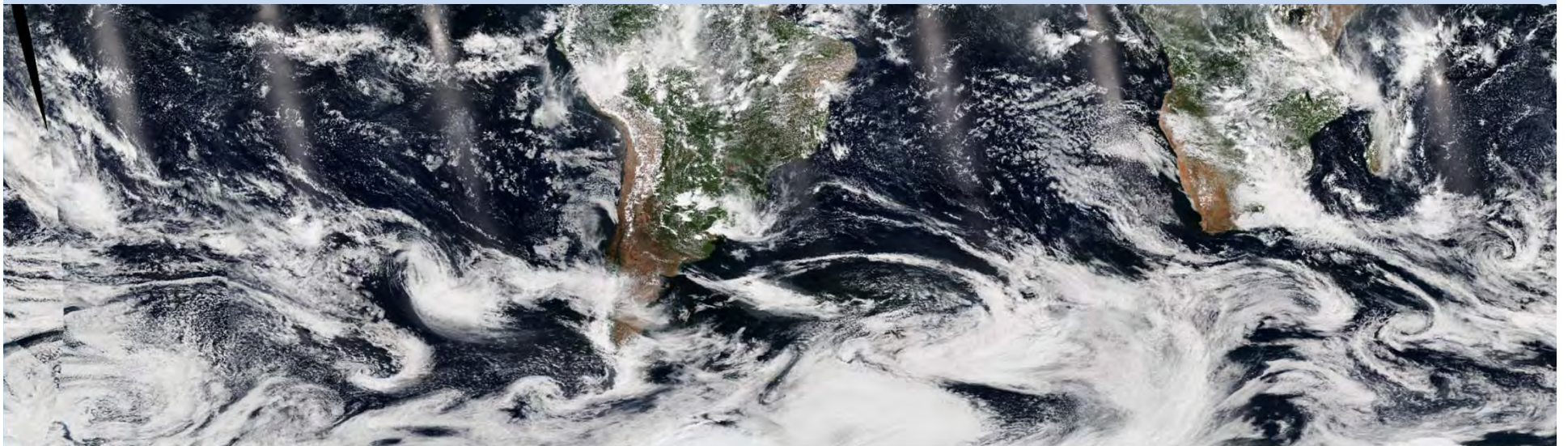

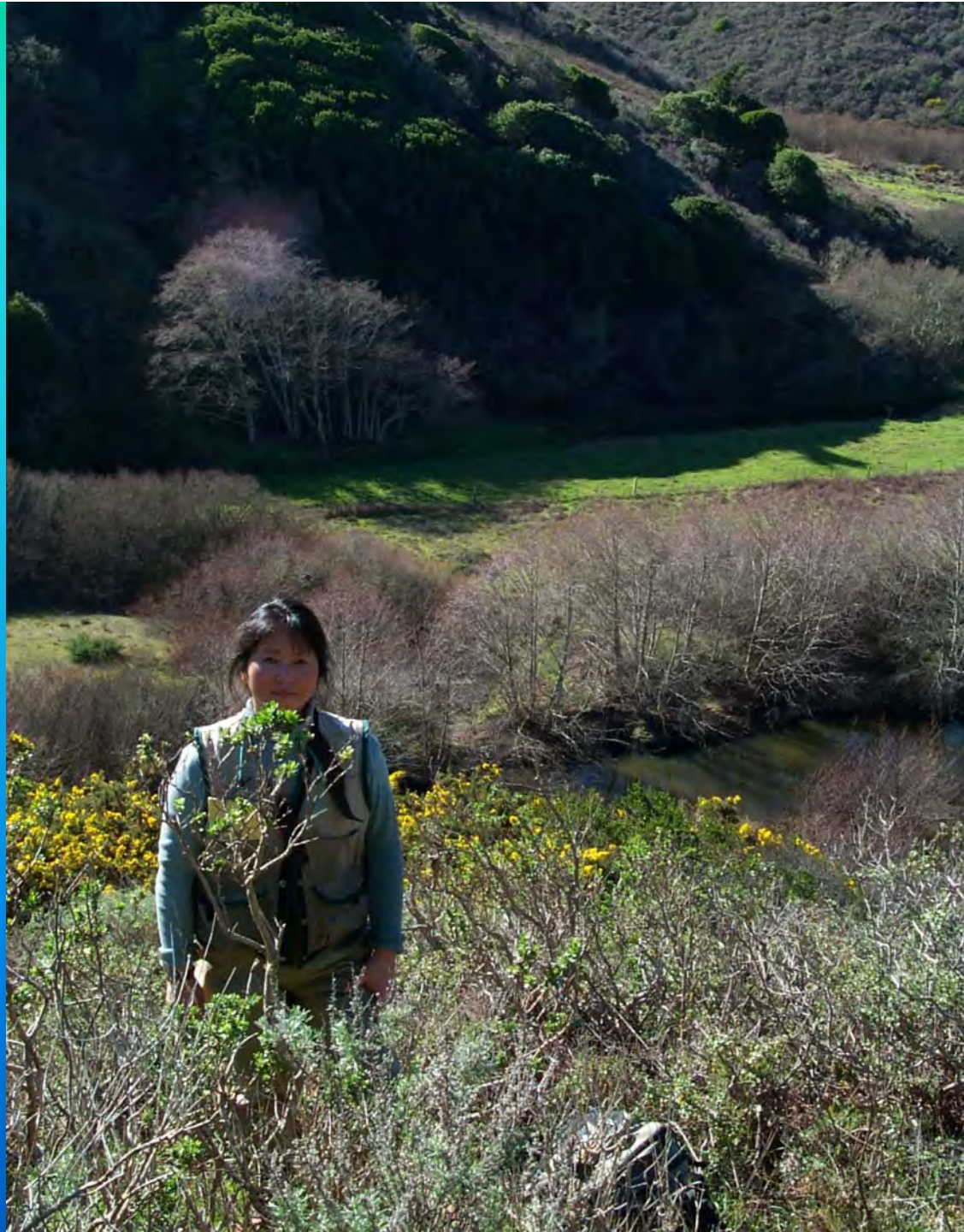

Since joining CDFW Gail has:

- spent countless hours advocating for salmonids and their precious habitat;
- pursued restoration projects from concept to design to implementation;
- Reviewed hundreds of FRGP and other grant funded proposals;

- Was the Basin planner for Napa, Sonoma and Marin Counties;
- has been the FRGP lead for the Bay Delta Region since 2008;
- And managed hundreds of grants totaling well over \$25,000,000!

Just a few examples....

- Pine Gulch Creek Instream Flow Enhancement Project
- Stuart Creek barrier removal
- Big Lagoon Wetland and Creek Restoration, Muir Beach, Marin County, CA

- Before Construction (from the north looking southeast)



- After Construction (from the north looking southeast)



- 17 years from start to finish
- \$2.5 M (mostly FRGP funded)
- Saves 61.5 acre feet (about 1 cfs) of water during the summer low-flow season
- Protects flow for over 6 miles of creek.

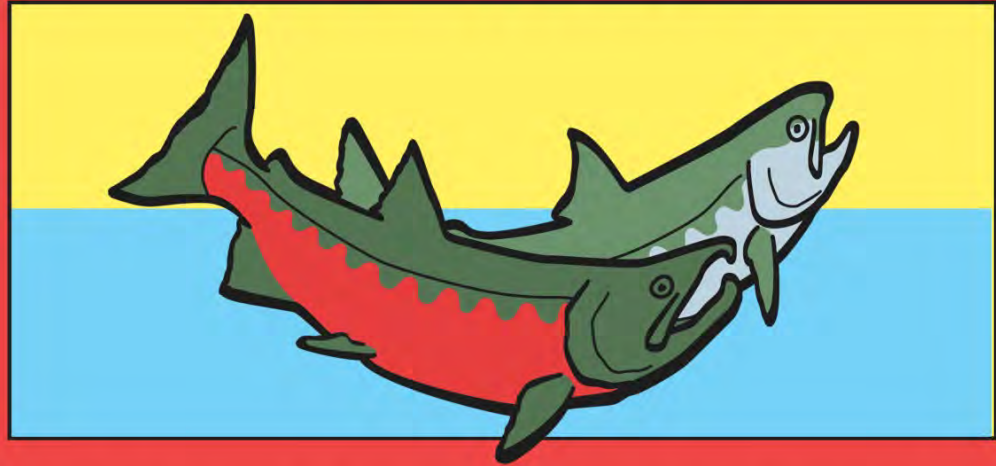


"The biggest risk right now is not doing anything at all," said Gail Seymour, Senior Environmental Scientist Supervisor with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

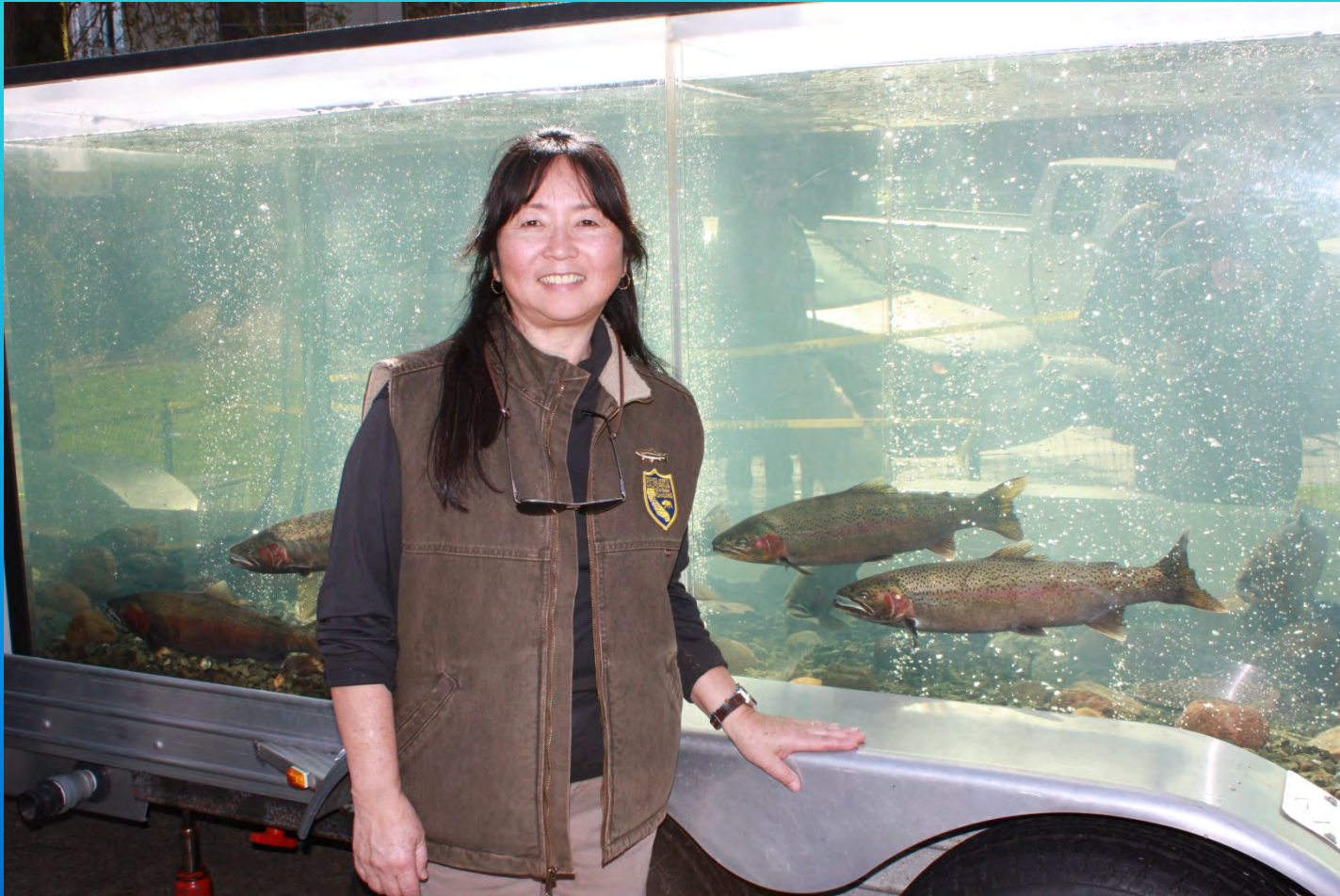

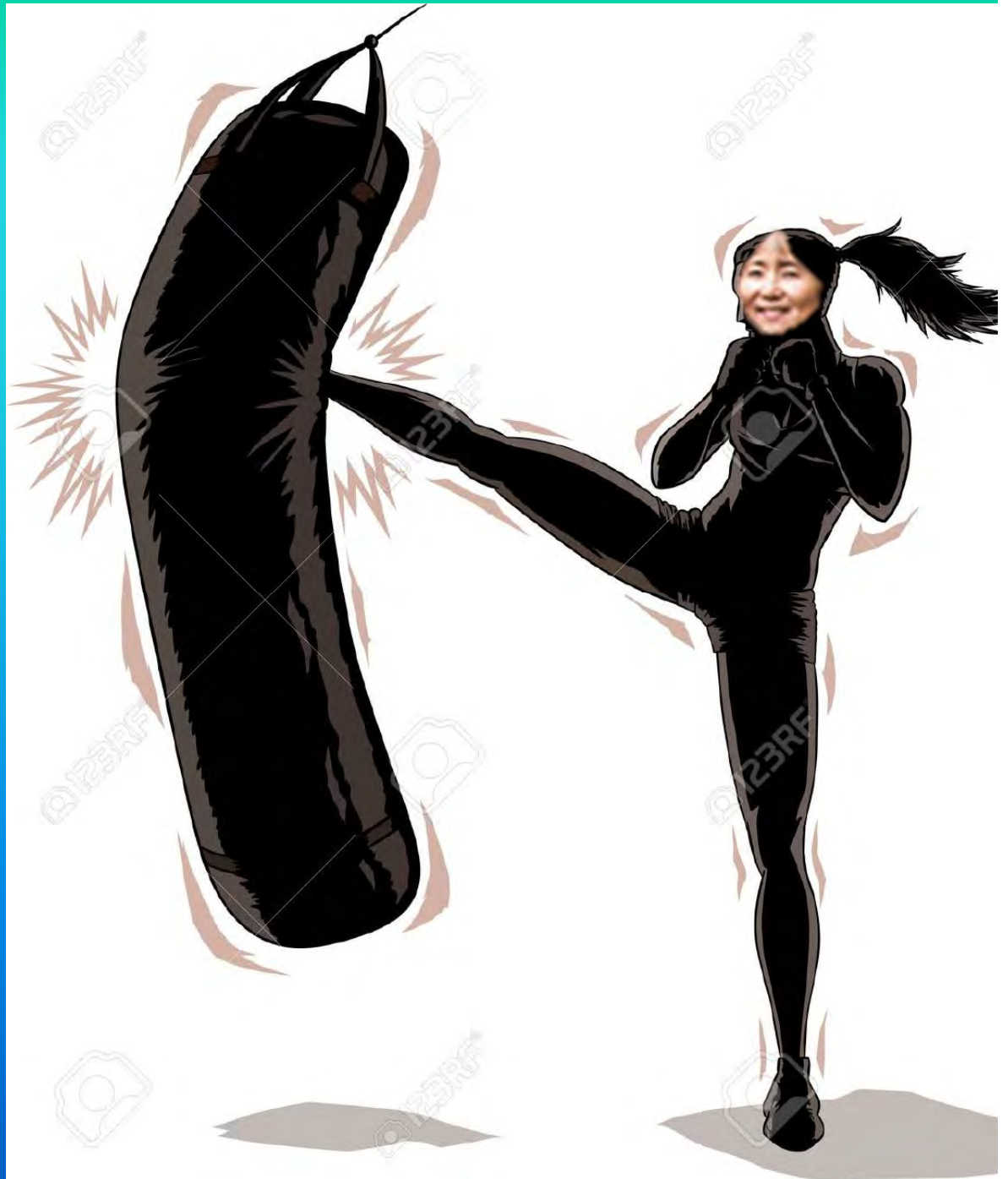
